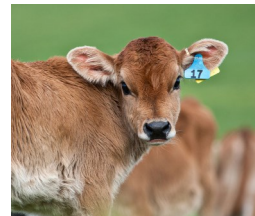
This is us.

Sausage sizzle starts at 12pm. Please complete the order form below and return as soon as possible so we know what to buy!

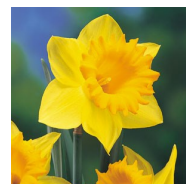

A notice with further entry information will follow shortly.

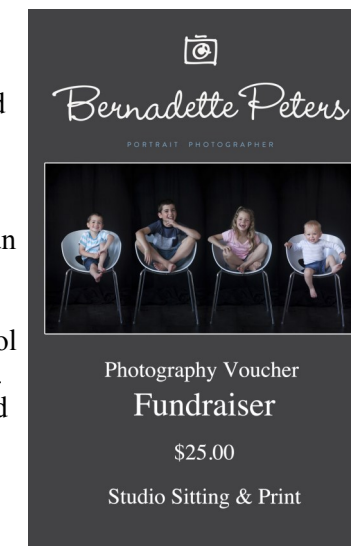
Friends of Glen Oroua School are pleased to offer this fundraising opportunity to our community.
